Solemn Assembly is a call to repentance and a commitment to seek the face of God with a willing heart. This call is seen in Joel 1:14, 2:12-14 and Isaiah 58. This is a call to a Biblical fast to allow us to individually and collectively turn our hearts toward the Lord as we begin 2019. Solemn Assembly is a pause from life as usual to look toward the Living God. It serves to demonstrate our unity as one Body in Christ (Ephesians 4) in the coming year.

The focus for Solemn Assembly 2019 is on “Expanding Kingdom Territory,” from Romans 15:20. We welcome transfer growth, but in 2019 we want to make sure we are diligent in engaging and sharing the Gospel with our unchurched neighbors and city. As we seek more facility space, it is not just about space, but also to expand the mission that God has called us to in the city by becoming and making disciples by the power of God.

SOME AREAS OF FOCUS

- Personal, community and city evangelism (Colossians 4:2-6)
- Seeking the Lord about where we are called to be in terms of location to fulfill God’s mission for Epiphany Fellowship in the city (Acts 16:6-10)
- Deepening our disciple-making systems (Titus 2)
- Helping people to reach their divine purpose in Christ and deepen their commitment to pursuing the Gospel of Christ (Ephesians 5:16)
- Engaging men and increasing their presence to make up 50% of Epiphany Fellowship’s congregation. In addition, that they would become committed disciples by growing and maturing in the faith (Colossians 1:28)

GUIDELINES FOR SOLEMN ASSEMBLY

- Fast during 1, 2, or all 3 time slots focusing on prayer and Bible reading
- Spend time praying during the time you usually eat
- No TV
- No web surfing (unless job related)
- No Social Media
- No Blogging
- Read your Bible, pray, and connect to other believers
